She (hear) some noise from the neighbour's flat, so she (keep) calling for help until the neighbours and the fire-fighters (find) her.	She (feel) relieved when she (be) back in the flat and (go) to the kitchen to eat something: she (find) some crackers in the cupboard.
Unfortunately, they (be) fried in peanut oil and Ursula (be) allergic to peanuts.	She (catch a taxi again and (run) to the ER to get some help.
Fortunately, a young doctor (be) in charge, who immediately (understand) the problem and (can) save her.	She and the doctor (know) straight away that they (be) made for each other: they (get) married one year later.
